16. Are there any permit costs – either for electrical or water that will need to be paid by the contractor?


We have provided a sheet attached, that shows the Duke Energy power locations. Contractor to provide a unit price, per foot for this item. Coordination will be made with successful bidder during construction, to meet with a representative from Duke Energy to coordinate the connections.

ADDITIONAL ITEM:

The project will require the addition of a potable water meter backflow preventers to be installed on the single-family easement sites, if reclaimed water is currently not being used. An item has been added to the Unit Price Bid sheet for this item. Some multi-family sites may

not have the backflow preventers. This will be discoverable in-field during construction. Add unit price for this item and it will be determined in-field
